**Phase I — December 2004- January 2005**

**Minutes of the meeting held in Malta on 27-28 November 2004  
and  
Additional comments and suggestions from Participants**

**a) Minutes of the meeting held in Malta on 27-28 November 2004**

All the Participants having attended the Malta Meeting will receive a “non paper” containing the complete Minutes of the event. This will serve as a working document.

→ **deadline: end December 2004.**

**b) Additional comments and suggestions from Participants in the Malta Meeting**

Concerning the documents circulated at the meeting, especially the Structuring Remarks, may we ask you to please send us by electronic mail all additional comments, amendments or suggestions you may have in relation to the issues and concrete projects proposed. The compilation and analysis of these comments will enable us to produce an Interim Report, based on the preliminary papers presented in Malta by Prof. Lannon and Prof. Hadhri, on the minutes of the meeting as well as on **additional comments and suggestions you would like to add now**. To this end, we would very much appreciate to receive by end January 2005:

**i) A small note including :**

- **a short description of all the issues** pertaining to the region or to the topics discussed in Malta **in which your organisation/institutions are interested ;**
- **a list of the budgetary facilities for the region**, available and/or required by your organisation/institutions in the medium and in the long term (please also give the respective Internet link leading to the programme(s) in question);
- **a list of the persons in your organisation/institutions working on the issues mentioned**, or of other individuals in your institutions or other related organisations who could be interested in the EMI Project (their e-mail address, telephone and facsimile number, postal address and Internet site);
- **a list of individuals, institutions and organisations which you think we should invite to the Congress**, to whom we would also be sending the Intermediate Report 2005.

**ii) A memorandum (maximum 10 pages) containing :**

- your **supplementary comments and suggestions as to the issues and concrete projects discussed** during the Malta meeting;
- **a precise list** (ten bullet points) **of the principal obstacles encountered** by your organisation/institutions during the set-up and/or implementation phase of important projects relating to the region concerned by the North-South Mediterranean Dialogue.

→ **deadline: 31 January 2005**

**Phase II — January-July 2005  
Interim Report**

Following the compilation of the material received during Phase I, we will produce an Interim Report on the basis of the following elements :

- i) the preliminary reports ;
- ii) the minutes of the Malta meeting;
- iii) the additional comments and suggestions received.

**→ deadline for dispatch of the Interim Report: July 2005**

**Phase III  
Final Report**

**a) Last comments from participants in the Malta meeting and others receiving the Interim Report**

Following the principle of an open and constructive dialogue, individuals/organisations will have three months to react to the Interim Report and for sending us their further suggestions/comments by Mid October. From this material we will produce the Final Report.

**→ deadline for last remarks concerning the Interim Report: Mid October 2005**

During the Luxemburg (January-June 2005) and the UK (July 2005-December 2005) presidency, it is planned to present the Interim Report at various meetings dealing with Euro-Mediterranean matters; at their request, it may also be presented at similar meetings of the Arab countries.

**b) North-South Mediterranean talks on issues concerning the Congress (March to December 2005)**

In accordance with suggestions made during the preparatory conference and in order to extend the process started in Malta, it is planned to organise a series of encounters with representatives of civil society, especially in the countries South of the Mediterranean. **We would very much welcome your helpful suggestions in support of this objective.**

**c) Dispatch of official invitations, preparation of the Congress and circulation of the Final Report**

**- Dispatch of official invitations: Mid November 2005**

**- Circulation of the Final Report: December 2005**

The Final Report will contain a synthesis of the entire process initiated in November 2004 by the Malta conference. It will describe the results of ten months of dialogue and consultation and provides a basis for establishing the various working groups and panels of the Congress.

**- Congress 2006: date et venue will be decided by the Organisational Committee in September**
